- Wear your rink shirt, if you don't have one, see Miss Jen. Dress appropriately for the weather.
 Cool temps wear long sleeves under your rink shirt or wear rink hoodie. Warm temps wear sunscreen.

SKATERS:

- Anyone wishing to skate may do so. However, you skate at your own risk and you must be able
 to skate the entire parade route and keep up with the rink entry. No additional seats will be
 available on the float.
- Provide your own skates with proper wheels. Outdoor wheels are available at the rink at a 20% discount now through Thursday, April 25. Supplies are limited so please let us know what you need no later than Sunday, April 21 so we can get more ordered if needed. We can assist you in changing out your wheels but this MUST be done no later than Thursday, April 25.
- Safety gear is highly recommended falling on asphalt is very different than falling on the hardwood floor inside the rink and asphalt will cause abrasions! Wrist guards and knee pads (roller derby quality) are available at the rink. Supplies are limited so please let us know what you need no later than Sunday, April 21 so we can get more ordered if needed.
- Must have Parent Permission Form and Photo Release Form turned in to rink no later than Thursday, April 25.
- Wear your rink shirt, if you don't have one, see Miss Jen. Dress appropriately for the weather.
